### Face coverings at Services

Following the introduction of a requirement for face coverings to be worn in shops and certain other public places, it has now become mandatory to also do so during church services. There are certain exemptions, such as the President and those assisting e.g. reading, preaching, leading prayers and deaconing.

It has been wonderful for some of us to be able to unite physically again in our churches for worship and, in particular for many, to receive Communion. Those who have come have talked about how calm, peaceful, measured, cared for and safe our services feel while following social distancing and hygiene procedures.

Alongside our services in church, the blessings of technological development allow for us to also worship together while remaining in our homes.
